

The College Service Learning Internship Programme (SLIP) is designed for students who have a desire to serve others and are interested in building relationships with the poor and disadvantaged communities by working for the non-governmental organizations (NGO). This is a great opportunity to integrate your classroom learning with real life experience through service. If you want to engage on a deeper level while working with people who have dedicated their lives to helping others, this programme is for you!



(S2) Nanao Shumei Natural Farm (南澳阿聰自然田)

2-3 weeks in May to July

Students will handle events' logistic needs, such as outdoor activities, seminars and guesthouse. Additionally, students are taught how to practice sustainable agriculture without using artificial pesticides and fertilizers.

(S3) Taiwan Toy Library Association (台灣玩具圖書館協會) 19 June to 30 July

Students will be sent to different service units of Taiwan Toy Library Association in Taoyuan City to help with administrative tasks, plan events and intercultural activities, and other things.





(S4)The Carpenter's House (木匠的家關懷協會) 19 June to 30 July

Students help run the thrift shop at The Carpenter's House in Taoyuan City on a day-to-day basis, helping bring reclaimed wood and clothing design to life. In addition, students help organize various activities for seniors and design standard operating procedure.

OBLIGATIONS OF STUDENTS

- Students should be cooperative and take initiative in liaising with the Dean of Students' Office, United College.
- Students are obliged to participate in official functions organized by the Dean of Students' Office and receiving NGO and organization, eg pre-trip briefing session, preparation meetings, review session, post-trip follow-up activities etc.
- Selected students are required to submit a learning journal & photos **OR** video clip upon the completion of programme for publication/future promotion of the programme.
- Updated information will be disseminated via email and applicants should check their **CUHK email address** frequently.

Fill in the online application form and submit an essay within 500 words in Chinese on "What do you expect to gain in the Service Learning Internship Programme" **by 12:00nn, 6 March 2023**.

FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENT

- Participants will be insured under the University's Group Travel Insurance package. He / She may consider taking out additional insurance as deemed appropriate.
- All selected students will shoulder their own direct expenses e.g. air tickets, visa application, inter-city transportation, lodge, meal, etc. Besides, all selected students are required to pay **HK\$1,500** as deposit of the programme, which will be fully refunded after the completion of programme.
- Participants should arrange all transportation and lodge by themselves.
- Upon satisfactory completion of all the programme requirements, students will be eligible for consideration of the United College GOAL Scholarships supported by the College Endowment Fund. The maximum amount of which per student is to be confirmed.

REMARKS



A student will not be granted more than one award per year under the United GOAL Programme series, between 1 September 2022 and 31 August 2023, except those located in Mainland China and Taiwan.
