Programme Features:

This 2-week Programme will include 42 hours of intensive Spanish course at different levels and cultural activities organised by the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona (UAB) in Barcelona, Spain.



Duration: 3 – 18 June, 2023 (tentative)



Fees: *HKD\$18,700 fees include language course, cultural activities organized by UAB, accommodation, meals (breakfast & dinner) and round trip air-fare. Fees such as local transport, visa application, other personal expenses and expenses related to COVID-19 tests and guarantine measures are not included.

Accommodation:

Students will be staying with local families during the Programme.

Eligibility:

United College students of all disciplines and years are eligible to apply.

Quota:

20 students

Credit Transfer: Upon satisfactory completion of the language course, students may apply for transfer of 3 credits in Spanish (to be evaluated on a case-by-case basis) and may consider to further their Spanish studies at CUHK (Minor Programme in Spanish, 18 credits).

Scholarships:

Upon satisfactory completion of all the programme requirements, students will be eligible for consideration of the United College GOAL Scholarships supported by the College Endowment Fund. The maximum amount of which per student is HK\$6,500.

Programme Requirements:

All participants are required to:

- attend all the pre-departure lectures, briefings, meetings organised by the College to prepare themselves for the Programme;
- assist the College in the promotion of cultural exchange activities;
- share with other students their experience;
- submit a written report to the College after the Programme. The College reserves the right to edit the report for publication purposes.
