- 2. submit an official transcript issued by the attended University as a proof of completing the course(s);
- 3. obtain approval from faculties / departments to transfer the credits of the course(s) taken back to CUHK;
- 4. submit a written report to the College within one month upon returning to Hong Kong. The College reserves the right to edit the report for publication purposes;
- assist the College in the promotion of cultural exchange activities (such as production of display boards, webpage and to share with other College students their experience abroad);
- Upon satisfactory completion of the above requirements, students will be eligible for consideration of the United College GOAL Scholarships supported by the College Endowment Fund according to the following rate: Region 1 : Asia and Oceania – HK\$8,000 (1 course) or HK\$10,000 (2 courses) Region 2 : Europe and Americas – HK\$10,000 (1 course) or HK\$15,000 (2 courses)

Selection of the Scholarships will be based on:

- 1. Applicant's Overall GPA;
- 2. Applicant's participation in the extra-curricular activities organised by the College;
- 3. Priority will be given to those who have no previous overseas exchange experience.

- 3. submit a written report to the College within one month upon returning to Hong Kong. The College reserves the right to edit the report for publication purposes;
- 4. assist the College in the promotion of cultural exchange activities (such as production of display boards, webpage and to share with other College students their experience abroad);
- 5. Upon satisfactory completion of the above requirements, students will be eligible for consideration of the United College GOAL Scholarships of **HK\$10,000 or HK\$15,000*** supported by the College Endowment Fund.

- 4. submit a written report to the College within one month upon returning to Hong Kong. The College reserves the right to edit the report for publication purposes;
- assist the College in the promotion of cultural exchange activities (such as production of display boards, webpage and to share with other College students their experience abroad);
- 6. Upon satisfactory completion of the above requirements, students will be eligible for consideration of the United College GOAL Scholarships of **HK\$10,000 or HK\$15,000*** supported by the College Endowment Fund.
