Programme Features :

This 2-week Programme will include 42 hours of intensive Spanish course at different levels and cultural activities organised by the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona (UAB) in Barcelona, Spain.



Possible Durations:

30 May – 14 June 2026 or 27 June -12 July 2026 (tentative, will confirm in late Jan 2026)

Fees: *HKD\$11,200 per student. This includes the language course, cultural activities organised by UAB, accommodation, and meals (breakfast and dinner). Expenses such as round-trip airfare, local transportation, visa application, and other personal expenses are not included. **Please note that students are responsible for purchasing their own round-trip air tickets. For more information, please refer to the FAQ.**



Accommodation:

Students will be staying with local families during the Programme.

Eligibility:

United College students of all disciplines and years are eligible to apply. UAB will assess applicants' Spanish proficiency and place them in appropriate classes (elementary, intermediate, or advanced) based on an online test conducted prior to departure.

Quota:

15 students

Credit Transfer:

Upon satisfactory completion of the language course, students may apply for transfer of 3 credits in Spanish (to be evaluated on a case-by-case basis) and may consider furthering their Spanish studies at CUHK (Minor Programme in Spanish, 18 credits).

Scholarships:

Upon satisfactory completion of all the programme requirements, students will be eligible for consideration of the United College GOAL Scholarships supported by the College Endowment Fund. The maximum amount per student is **HK\$8,000**.

Programme Requirements:

All participants are required to:

- attend all pre-departure lectures, briefings, and meetings organized by the College to prepare for the Programme;
- participate in all lessons and activities arranged by UAB;
- support the College in promoting cultural exchange activities;
- share their experiences in Spain with fellow students;
- complete the post-trip questionnaire and submit a written report to the College after the Programme. The College reserves the right to edit the report for publication purposes.
