

United College, The Chinese University of Hong Kong **Non-local Credit-bearing Summer Studies Scheme**

This Scheme is established by the College Endowment Fund which provides scholarships for College students to attend credit-bearing summer courses (online/ remote teaching) offered by the following universities in the summer of 2022:

- University of California, Berkeley, USA (http://summer.berkeley.edu/)
- University of California, Los Angeles, USA (https://www.summer.ucla.edu/)

To be eligible for consideration of the Scholarships, students are required to:

- 1. attend at least one credit-bearing course offered by the above Universities#;
- 2. obtain approval from faculties / departments to transfer the credits of the course(s) taken back to CUHK;
- 3. submit an official transcript issued by the attended University as a proof of completing the course(s);
- 4. submit a written report about 500 words to the College within one month upon completion of the course(s). The College reserves the right to edit the report for publication purposes;
- 5. assist the College in the promotion of cultural exchange activities;
- upon satisfactory completion of the above requirements, students will be eligible to receive a scholarship equivalent to 50% of the programme fees or HK\$6,000, whichever is lower.

Selection will be based on:

- 1. Applicant's Overall GPA;
- 2. Applicant's participation in the extra-curricular activities organised by the College;
- 3. Study Plan:
- 4. Interview may be required;
- Priority will be given to those who have no previous overseas exchange experience.



Application and Deadline:

- 1. Application & Deadline: Please apply on-line here. The deadline for application is 25 February 2022 (by 12:00 noon). Late application will not be considered;
- 2. Students selected for UCLA will submit the application to UCLA through United College while students selected for UC Berkeley are required to submit the online application to UC Berkley by themselves directly. United College will provide some basic guidelines on application.
- 3. Students are advised to check the webpage of the respective Universities for detailed information on admission requirements and courses available for enrollment.
