

Introduction of 2022-23 College Assemblies, United College, CUHK (GEUC 1000)

[Date and Time]

There are 6-10 College Assemblies to be held at Sir Run Run Shaw Hall in 2 Academic Terms of each year, while some smaller scale College Assemblies will be held on the College and University campus. The “College Assembly Time” is usually 11:30 am to 1:00 pm on Fridays, while some afternoon College Assemblies will be organized too. For other related activities such as seminars and lectures, details on time and venue will be released on College Assembly website.

[Content and Format]

Guests from different fields are invited to give speeches at College Assemblies, other formats like group discussion and performance will be arranged also. Themes of assemblies will be of culture, art, science and social affairs areas, as well as on enhancing personal growth of students.

[Attendance Requirement]

1. “College Assemblies” (GEUC 1000) is part of the College General Education Programme. It is non-credit bearing but with an attendance requirement.
2. For **each Term**, students are required to attend at least 3 College Assemblies or related activities (3 times in Term 1, 3 times in Term 2).
3. Engineering students in one-year-work-study, Medicine students and Nursing students in clinical studies are not required to attend College Assemblies.
4. Students are encouraged to fill in an E-evaluation questionnaire at the end of the College Assembly.
5. The College will give grade to students according to the attendance records of each Term:
[Pass] for “attendance requirement fulfilled”
[Fail] for “not fulfilling attendance requirement”

Duggan Professor in Public Administration Chair, Department of Public Policy and Management Sol Price School of Public Policy University of Southern California</p> <p>Topic: How to Think about Institutions, Behavior, and Governance</p> <p>-----</p> <p><u>Highlights:</u> Based on a new book project, Professor Tang will examine ways of thinking about institutions, behavior, and governance by raising several fundamental questions. By reviewing the rationales, recent research, and evolving answers to these questions, the lecture will help us understand some of the perennial challenges of building and sustaining good governance in China, the United States, and beyond. Professor Tang will also reflect on what he learned as a student at United College and how it has helped shape his intellectual development. Some of the questions addressed in the lectures include:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. How to preserve liberty in the age of equality? 2. How to make informal rules/norms support good governance? 3. Is centralized government and decentralized administration possible? 4. How to develop enduring civic associations that are independent of particularistic social relationships? 5. How can recent advances in behavioral theory enhance our understanding of institutions and governance?

Duggan Professor in Public Administration Chair, Department of Public Policy and Management Sol Price School of Public Policy University of Southern California</p> <p>Topic: How Macro-Institutional Contexts Constrain Environmental Governance: Comparing the United States and China</p> <p>-----</p> <p><u>Highlights:</u> Professor Tang will examine how marco-institutional contexts constrain options for environmental governance by drawing on his research on the US and Chinese environmental management systems. Using examples in water resource management and air pollution control from both countries, he will explore how fundamental differences in the two governing systems affect their respective approaches to addressing environmental problems. The relative strengths and weaknesses of the two systems will also be examined.</p>
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
