Shum Wai Yau and Kong Fook To Belt and Road First-in-the-Family Tertiary Education Admission Scholarship

Aim

This admission scholarship aims at encouraging the United College non-local Year-one students (through Non-JUPAS) who come from Belt and Road countries and are the first generation in the family to actively participate in various college activities on campus as well as striving for study time for better academic results.

Quota and Amount

There are 10 quotas, in the amount of HK\$20,000 each. The Scholarship is renewable in the normative period of study for a maximum tenure of 4 years if the awardees attain a GPA of 3.0 or better with good conduct.

Eligibility

- 1. The applicant must be a non-local Year-one undergraduates of United College (through Non-JUPAS) coming from *Belt and Road countries.

- 2. The applicant must be a first-generation university student in the family. Parents must not have attended any institution of higher education, but his/her siblings with university experience are acceptable.

Selection

- 1. Selection will primarily be assessed by the applicant's public examination results. Non-academic achievement may also be considered.
- 2. Short-listed candidates will be interviewed by a panel appointed for this purpose by the College Scholarships and Student Finance Committee in October.
