



GEUC1011 “University Life and Learning” / GEJC1120 “College, University and Community”

Important Notes for Freshmen in 2021-22

1. GEUC1011 “*University, Life and Learning*” is a required general education course for all United College freshmen in the first term of the first undergraduate year. Classes will be held on every Friday afternoon from 1:45pm to 3:15pm., at Sir Run Run Shaw Hall.
2. To take care of non-local students, our College has joined hands with other two Colleges, Chung Chi and New Asia, in offering GEUC1120 “*College, University and Community*”. The contents are similar to GEUC1011, but the medium of teaching is English. Noticing that there will be students facing travel restrictions or have other compelling reasons which prevent them from travelling back to Hong Kong for classes, all lectures will be recorded and uploaded on the online platform. Non-local freshmen will be assigned to this course, and the first class meeting is scheduled on 17 September 2021.
3. Course registration will be done automatically, students **DO NOT** need to register via CUSIS (Chinese University Student Information System). Students please check your respective course roster via CUSIS and verify if the information is correct. For discrepancies, please contact the College General Education Office at 3943 7570. If you could understand Cantonese and master Chinese, you are strongly encouraged to swap from GEJC1120 to GEUC1011. Please submit your application on or before Monday, 13 September 2021 to the General Education Office, Room 201, Tsang Shiu Tim Building, United College.
